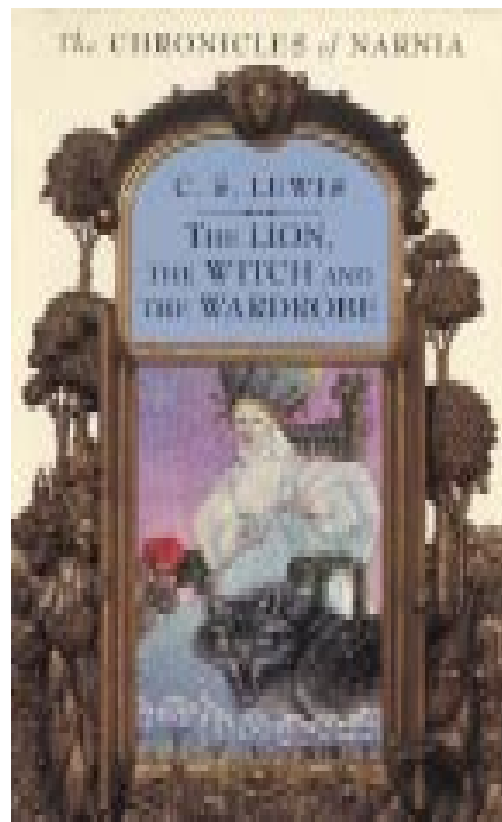

## CERRO COSO DRAMA CONDUCTS AUDITIONS

The Cerro Coso Community College Drama Department is gearing up for a busy and exciting fall semester. The Theatre Production Class will be producing the Musical *Narnia*. *Narnia* based on the children's book, *The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe*. The story follows four siblings who unintentionally fall into the magical land of Narnia by way of their uncle's wardrobe. During their stay in Narnia, the children encounter several Narnian creatures, including the White Witch, Aslan the Lion, Tumnus the faun, and a band of Cruelies. Before making their way back home, the children find themselves involved in a battle pitting good against evil.

There are many, many acting roles available for adult singers, non-singers, dancers and musicians. No experience is necessary. Performers who wish to audition should enroll for the "Theatre Production" class, course reference number 71656, now. Auditions will be held the first week of class. Class begins on August 30 and

will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:30-9:39 pm. Students wishing to work behind the scenes on the musical should enroll for the "Technical Theatre" class, course reference number 71657. This class also begins on August 30 and will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:15-9:11 pm.



Technical Theatre students will support the production of *Narnia* by working on various technical elements, including setting lights, sound, makeup, costumes, props, publicity, stage management, and choreography.

Additional courses offered by the Drama Department this fall include "Movement for the Actor," "Improvitations," and "Fundamentals of Acting." "Movement for the Actor" is an exciting new course focusing on stage movement and physical characterization. Students will develop physical skills through lively class explorations and activities. The course will also introduce students to period-style movement with special emphasis on the plays of Moliere. This class is held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:00-7:25 pm beginning on August 31, 2004.

Students who sign up for "Improvitation" will carry on the tradition of the "Who Said What Now?" Improv Troupe. Students will develop improvisation skills in class and perform as a troupe in public performances. Beginning on August 31 this class will meet every Tuesday and Thursday from 3:30-5:33 pm.

Four levels of acting classes will also be offered, including "Fundamentals of Acting," "Beginning Acting," "Intermediate Acting" and "Advanced Acting." All four levels of acting will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:00-6:03 pm.
