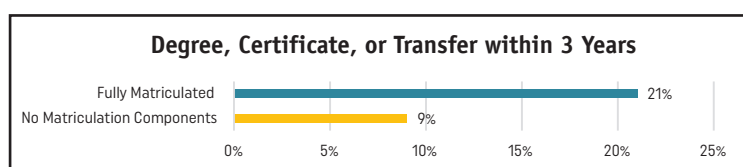
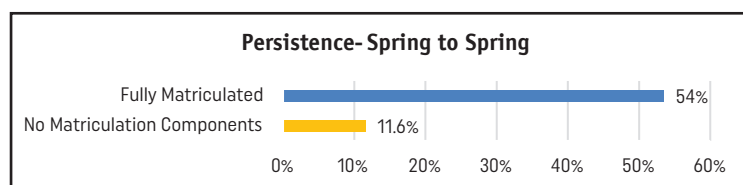
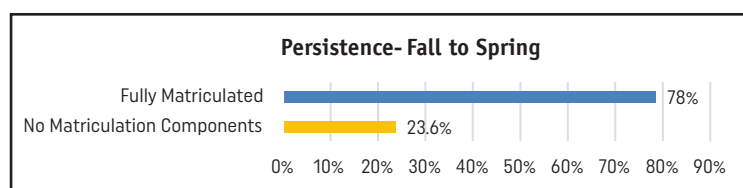
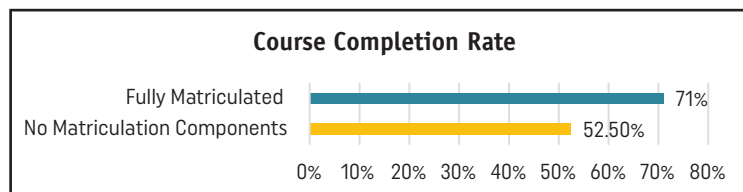
Student Success and Support Program

It Makes a Difference!

In the last two years, the State Chancellor's Office and the college have invested significant resources in increasing the number of students completing the Student Success and Support Program (SSSP) core services. This has been an important goal for staff and faculty across the college because of the positive correlation with success and retention. Students who complete more of the core services have a better chance of getting off to a fast and effective start to their college careers. And they are more likely to finish courses and complete programs. Here are the differences from last year:

- Assessment: Up 4%
- Orientation: Up 8
- Counseling: Up 8%
- Student Education Plan: Up 11%!
- Fully Matriculated (Onground): Up 10%!
- Fully Matriculated (Online): up 1%

On all milestone measures, students who have completed all four core services perform significantly better on important milestones achievements than those students who have not completed any components. From the **2014-2015 cohort year**:



Student Education Plans Keep Students Directed—Counseling Can Help!

The Class to Career project helps students explore career options and be proactive in developing educational plans. A counselor comes to class at three different points during the semester to give a 20 minute presentation on career and educational planning. The counselor provides resources to students and discusses information specifically related to certificate, degree and transfer programs. Class to Career presentations are even done online!
